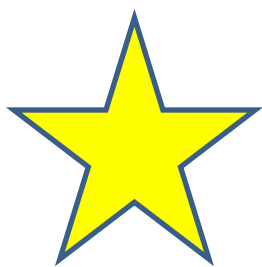
Dear Parents and Carers,

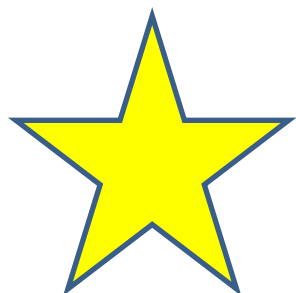

**Badger Class** Ted for his super progress in reading

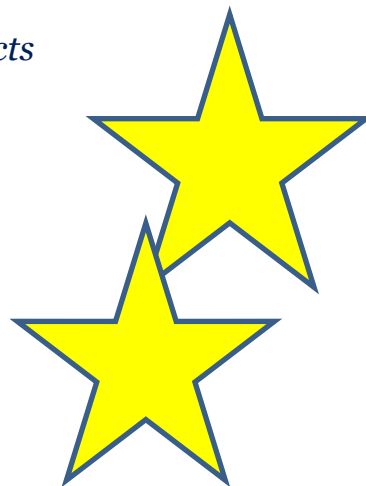
**Fox Class** Nathan for working extremely hard all week in all subjects
