Mrs Knee is the class teacher.

Reading

Please continue to read as often as possible with your child. We suggest a minimum of 3 times a week. Please note that I very rarely hear children read their reading books. However, I hear most children read most days through our 'taught read' sessions.

Times tables

These are coming along really well, but children need to keep practising them at home. By the end of this half term we will have covered all times tables to 12×12

Homework

Homework usually comes home on a Wednesday night and is to be returned on a Monday morning. This should be independent work where possible, should not be a battle and shouldn't take hours! There are usually a number of ways to approach each homework task to suit your family's time commitments.

Spellings

Most children are practising their spellings which come home on a Thursday for a test the following week however, many children report that they are not learning their year 3 / 4 spellings at home. Please request another list if yours has gone missing. Alternatively they are on the school website.

P.E. Will be on Monday and Wednesday afternoons .Children will need to have long hair tied back and preferably earrings out. Children **do** need outdoor PE shoes this half tem.
