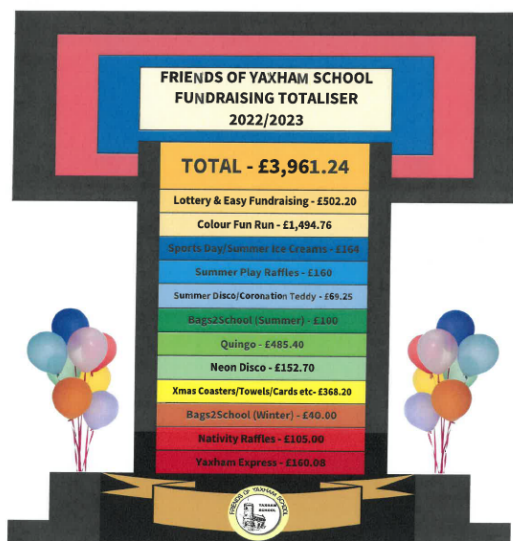
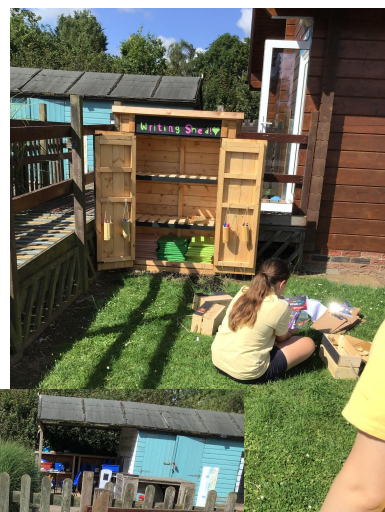
Dear Parents,
