- Cooking - chopping skills

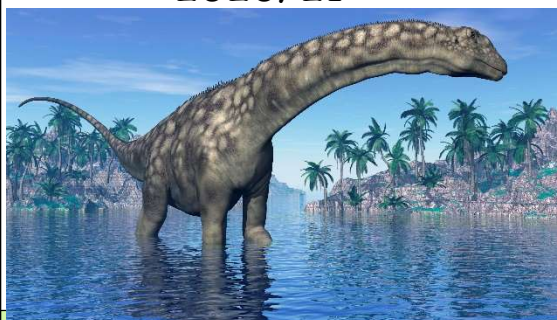
Understanding the World
