## **Other Messages**

#### Coronavirus Concerns

We continue to keep up to date with the latest advice and information. As you will be aware from news reports schools are to remain open during this stage of the plan. Norfolk County Council Children's Services are working closely together to ensure schools take the best and safest action for all concerned. As a school we are planning to ensure a good level of education can continue should we have to close, we will share this with you once plans have been finalised. Finally, we would like reassure you that the children have been really sensible and following advice regarding handwashing. When we have talked through effective washing, many children have said that is what they have been told at home too. (We thought it would be nice to hear that they are listening, we all know as parents we wonder sometimes!)

The current guidance is as follows:

The best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed to the virus.

There are general principles anyone can follow to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

- washing your hands often with soap and water, or use alcohol sanitiser if handwashing facilities are not available. This is particularly important after taking public transport
- covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throwing the tissue in a bin. See <u>Catch</u> <u>it, Bin it, Kill it</u>
- people who feel unwell should stay at home and should not attend work or any education or childcare setting
- pupils, students, staff and visitors should wash their hands:
  - before leaving home
  - on arrival at school
  - after using the toilet
  - after breaks and sporting activities
  - before food preparation
  - before eating any food, including snacks
  - before leaving school
- use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available
- avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- avoid close contact with people who are unwell
- clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- if you are worried about your symptoms or those of a child or colleague, please call NHS 111. Do not go directly to your GP or other healthcare environment
