Dear Parents,

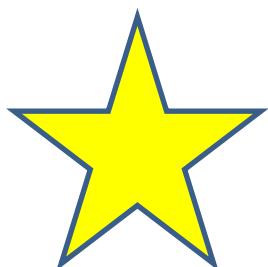

We wish everyone running lots of luck, have a great day and we look forward to hearing all about it!

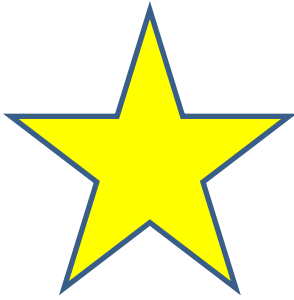

Hedgehog Class Lillie-Anne for a super attitude to learning and always working hard.

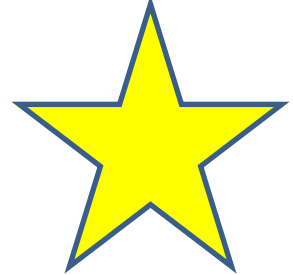
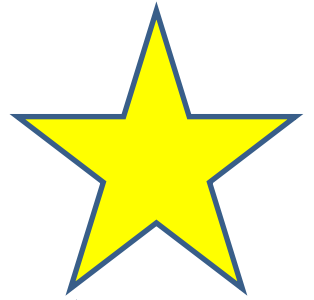
Badger Class Zosia for being extremely helpful to adults and class friends this week.
