Dear Parents,

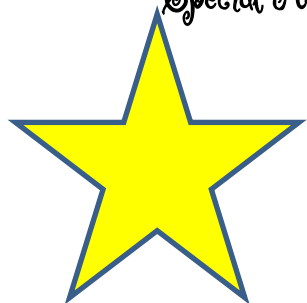
Thank you for your support this week coming onto the playground to collect your children. It really helps to keep the gateway and footpath clear so that families can leave as safely as possible.


