Free School Meals

Return to school

Educational provision remains in place for children of keyworkers and children in Reception, Year 1 and 6. If any of these categories apply to your child and you decided you would like them to return, you must contact us by 9am Thursday for a possibility of a place the following Monday. Places will remain limited during this period due to social distancing guidelines. This is educational provision rather than childcare; therefore, children are expected in school fulltime.

Children in school

Please can I remind parents that children cannot take unnecessary items from home to school and back again. They should not be bringing things to show their friends or teachers and should not be bringing any bags. We do appreciate this is difficult but this is important to try and prevent any passing of the virus from one place to another.
